Hi folks! Thanks for having me on Friday. It was so fun!

I realize I didn't mention that some perennial vegetable seeds require special treatment to germinate. For example, the Caucasian Spinach benefits from cold, moist stratification in the fridge this time of year. Or keep it easy and just wait until fall to plant the seeds!
