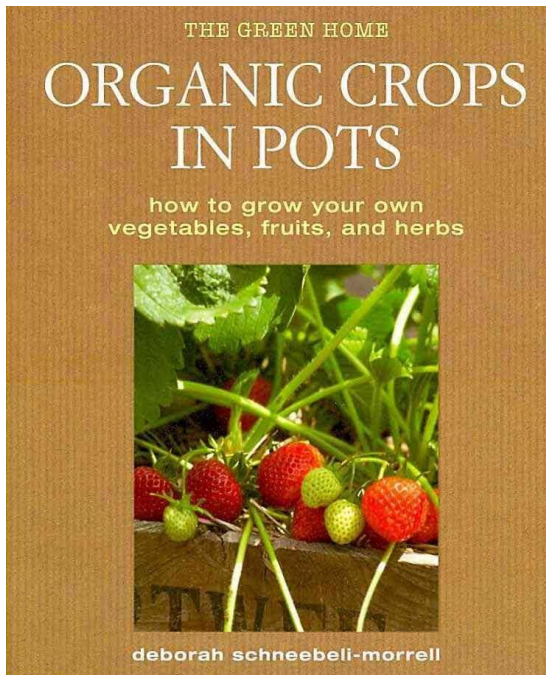


Book of the Month for June
